Elvehjem Neighborhood Association Board Meeting Minutes

Wednesday, October 4, 2023, 6:30-8:30 p.m. at Pinney Library

I. Welcome (6:30-6:45)

- a. Call to order (Dan) 6:35pm
 - i. Present: Dan, Alice, Kristy, Jacob, Andrew, Dylan. Absent: Pete, Bob, CJ, Kim.
- a. Approval of the agenda (All) Approved as written.
- **b.** Word on the Street (All) Rue Bourre & The Curious Crafter have opened in the Cottage Grove Rd shopping center.

II. Reports (6:45 – 7:00)

- **a. Secretary's report (Kristy)** We haven't yet received any submissions for our Helper List; will promote the list on Facebook.
- b. Treasurer's report (Jacob) see below

c. Echo report (Dan)

- i. The last regular invoice Jacob received from Thysse had the same invoice # as our advance postage invoice, making it difficult to pay. We're not sure of our balance with Thysse. Alice will check on our invoice & advance postage status.
- ii. For future reference, Thysse is pronounced "Tie-eese."
- **d.** Extra report (Pete) Extra went out. Typical number of opens; the helper list was the most clicked link. Next Extra will go out October 25th to crank up the energy for the bonfire list.

III. New Business (7:00 – 7:30)

- a. Neighborhood Grant planning (Pete & Dylan)
 - i. We discussed adding lighting (solar or otherwise) to the signs.
 - **ii.** Pete to provide clarification on if we have to spend grant money by end-of-year, or if we can still make purchases in 2024 for reimbursement under this grant.

b. Neighborhood Survey next steps

- i. Last follow-up request was sent out; survey is closed with 305 responses.
- ii. Dan will provide preliminary data for us to discuss at November meeting.

c. Garden Sign Committee (Dylan & Kristy)

i. **Mums & Pumpkins for \$100 from Amy?** We voted to veto this expenditure for this year, as the signs are being repainted/repaired during the first half of October. We'll revisit pumpkins & seasonal decor with the Garden Guild next year.

d. Welcome Committee latest (Jacob)

- i. Board members signed 'welcome' cards for new neighbors.
- ii. Kristy will get the LVM magnets to Jacob for distribution with the cards.

e. Design refresh? (Dan)

- Newsletter was last redesigned in 2019; logo was redesigned in 2014. Our current logo only exists in a rectangular form; would be nice to have one also in a square shape (to better fit Facebook profile picture, for example.)
- ii. We'll revisit this in later winter meetings. Dan will reach out to see if any neighbors are graphic designers who could volunteer some effort for this.

IV. Upcoming Events (7:30-8:30)

a. Halloween Bonfires, October 31 (Pete) - Pete to post form on Facebook next week and plug it weekly.

b. Turkey Trot, November 23 (Pete, Alice, & Dylan)

- i. Pete will test alternate routes next week.
- ii. CJ to send Pete his contact for port-a-potty rental.
- iii. We'll plan to have 2 tables at the event 1 for registration; 1 for donations (the one table got crowded last year).
- iv. Signage suggestions:
 - 1. Alice & Dylan suggested getting new signage made for the route.
 - 2. We would also like to have either an ENA sign made for the registration table (could be re-used for other events) or have a balloon arch to draw attention to the table.
 - 3. We should have a sign with our ENA Venmo code for registration.

c. Holiday in the Park, December 9 (Dan & Kristy)

- i. Horse & Carriage based on neighbor feedback, we didn't feel we could cancel the carriage this year.
 - Venue change? The carriage is very removed from the rest of the
 festivities at Elvehjem Park; we discussed moving the event to another
 park where the carriage would be more visible. Dan to check with the
 carriage company on the feasibility of Acewood or Droster parks.
 - 2. **Donations?** Because the carriage is a significant line item in the event budget, but not everyone will be able to get a ride, we discussed asking for optional donations to help offset costs.
 - 3. **Photo opps?** We discussed pausing rides mid-way through the event, and letting people take photos with Santa on the carriage. (So even if you don't get a ride, you can still interact with the horse & carriage.)
 - 4. **Sign-ups:** We will not do advanced registration this year; we will ask neighbors to sign up for a time slot when they arrive at the event.

ii. **Santa** - rather than building a workshop/throne for Santa in the shelter, we decided to have Santa sit on an adirondack chair by the bonfire. Neighbors can take their own pictures with Santa.

iii. Other party elements:

- 1. Light-up / glow-in-the-dark games
- 2. Carolers (Yahara River Chorus)
- 3. Holiday movie playing on outdoor screen (captions; no audio)
- 4. Hanukkah menorah
- 5. Food truck? (CJ do you have any contacts?)
- 6. Heat lamps? (Dylan has a small lamp.)

d. Holiday Lights Showcase? (Pete & Bob)

i. Suggestion to ask a neighbor if they want to own this project. Alice has a neighbor who might be interested.
