I. Welcome (6:30-6:45)

 - i. We discussed how to interpret survey data in light of the demographics of the survey respondents. We received ~300 responses; according to the City of Madison neighborhood website, there are ~4,000 residents of LVM.
 - 1. **Membership Map:** We're curious about where ENA members live within the neighborhood. Are there clusters of members? Are there underserved areas that could use more outreach? Pete volunteered to make a Google map with pins of all 2023 member addresses.
 - ii. Possible take-aways from the survey:
 - 1. Consider scheduling events <u>not</u> on/around a holiday weekend, to boost attendance.
 - 2. Consider some indoor events to be more accessible for folks.
 - a. **Bingo Night at the VFW?** Kim R. will look into details for scheduling something in Jan/Feb.
 - 3. Annual Meeting try to record it next year and share short videos on Facebook for marketing.
 - 4. From a bandwidth perspective, 2024 will be a big political year. We can lean into keeping neighbors informed (forums, listening sessions, etc).
