With Olbrich Park being a prime viewing location for the Rhythm and Booms firework display on Saturday, June 28, the Eastside Neighborhood Association Coalition (ENAC) will set up a thirst-quenching beverage booth with part of the proceeds from soda and water sales benefiting ENA.

A meeting is set for May 19 with alders and county supervisors of affected districts, concerned neighbors, quarry owners, and state assembly representative Melissa Sargent to discuss quarry blasting issues in our area. Vice President Isaac will be representing ENA at the meeting.

District 16 Alder Denise DeMarb is working on securing funding for a Cottage Grove Road Corridor Study to address safety, access, planning, and transportation concerns for this area, especially as the Grandview Commons and Royster Developments are constructed. Advisory committee members will be requested if funding is approved.

Our spring membership drive was a great success this year, thanks in part to the hard work of our district coordinators and block captains. As of May 20, we have received membership dues from 407 neighborhood households, which exceeds our goal, which I once thought to be overly optimistic, of 400 members. This is a 49 percent increase over last year's membership drive. In addition, we received donations above and beyond the \$15 dues amount from 74 of our neighbors, bringing the total raised by our membership drive to date to \$7,445 –a 28.3 percent improvement over last year's membership income. This is great news for our organization after seeing our resources dwindle over the past couple of years. This year's membership was truly an unqualified success.

I would also like to congratulate James Wilk, our neighbor on Painted Post Drive, who was the winner of our "Madison Night Out" drawing. All households who submitted their membership materials, postmarked or in hand, by April 30 were included in the prize drawing which includes a gift card to the Great Dane and a "Paint and Sip" package for two to Artful Escapes in Fitchburg. Both of these prizes were generously donated by the respective establishments in support of our membership.

Many thanks again to our district coordinators, block captains, and of course all of our neighbors, for making our neighborhood the great place that it is!


