
As of May 15 we have tallied 176 memberships received, out of our year's goal of 500. We expect that many more will be received by the end of May, as all households who have joined by May 31 are included in a drawing for a Madison Night Out. #### Treasurer's Report By Stacy Wellford stacy@elvehjemneighborhood.org

At our Annual Meeting on April 9th, I presented a summary of ENA's revenues and expenses from the 2015 calendar year, and submitted a proposed budget for 2016, which was approved by our neighbors in attendance. The budget included a profit but would only be obtained if we reach our budgeted membership level, the board has a 500 household membership goal so that we can increase our profit and continue with building a fund for large initiatives such as the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration in 2018. At the time this report was submitted, the membership drive is in full force and a full summary will be included in the next issue of the Echo, if you have not already done so please help support your neighborhood by becoming a member of the association for only \$15 a year. Year-to-date Echo advertising income received is about \$1500 and is consistent with the prior year at the same time. Thanks to all our local businesses that continue to support ENA through placing advertising ads.
